- \$9577 was netted for charities.
- Guild food consisted of ziti and salad from Les White and pies from Dan Klinglesmith.
- Club Hour 1.5

  - First year doing beer and food competitions in addition to door prize. Winners were:

    - Beer Go-BREW
  - Doing 3 different judgings made it take longer.

- Big thanks to Tom Flavin for help setting up Friday night.
- Winning raffle numbers posted to social media posed a screen size problem for people checking on their phones. Next time we might have some iPads/tablets available for folks to use.
- Some folks were cherry picking raffle prize bags. How to prevent this?
- Some folks entered via other entrances, such as the tap room, and didn't get their tickets scanned. We need to put up signs to direct people. Also, the designated entrance was dark. We need a light.
- Heavy Seas didn't like that people put stuff (jackets, etc) on the conveyor belts.
- Square
  - Used successfully with only \$55.72 in fees.
  - We only had one reader, forcing some folks to pay cash for raffle tickets, and this hurt sales. Maybe have 2 readers next time.
- People wasted cups. We might have cups made with the Guild logo for future events, and we'll raise ticket
  price if necessary to cover the cost. The cup will not have a year or list of clubs on it, and it can be used for
  other events.
- No issues with takedown or restrooms.
